CHAPTER SUMMARY : LIVING THINGS – 1) NEED FOOD - plants (Make their own food) .
Animals and Human beings (depend on plants and other animals).

2) BREATHE – Plants (through stomata), animals and Human beings (through lungs) , Fishes (through gills) and insects (through spiracles).

3) MOVE – plants do not move but some of its parts shows special movements. Animals and humans move on their own.

4)GROW - Plant growth (Seeds -> seedlings-> plants)

Animals and human growth (grow taller and increase in weight)

5) FEEL- Respond to their surroundings.

6) REPRODUCE- plants produce seeds which in turn grows into that particular type of plant.
Animals and humans give birth to their own kind.
