

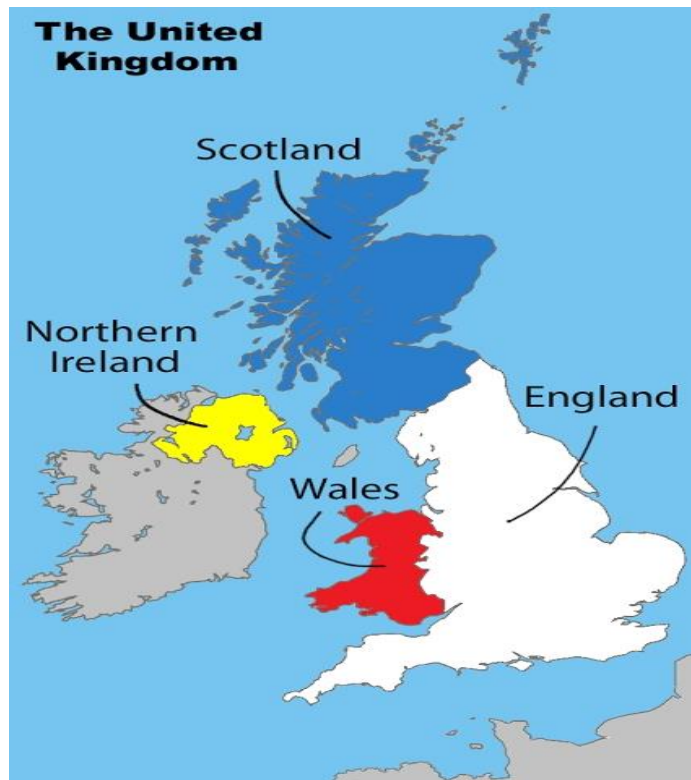
*Write down these questions and answers in your copy.*
