hot – cold

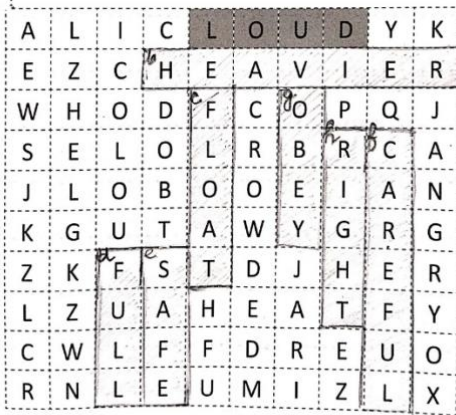
near – far
