Fly away , Paul!

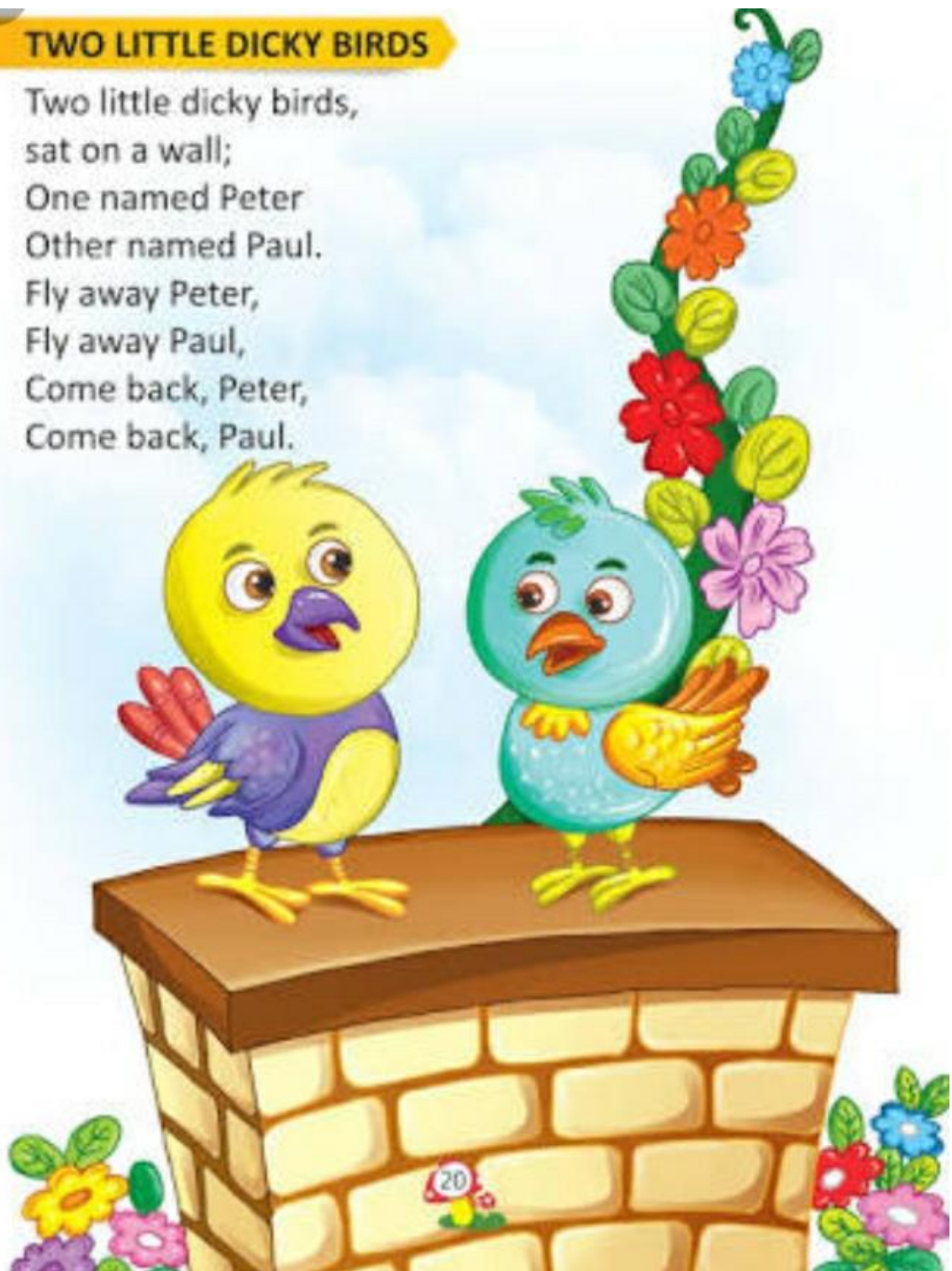
Come back , Peter!
