The Sentence

In this chapter we shall learn about kinds of sentence and subject and Predicate.

1.Kinds of Sentence

a. Assertive Sentence. Those which make a statement. Exap- He is a good boy.

b.Imperative Sentence- It is an expression of order,request ,advice.Exap- Please stay at home, do not go there.

c.Exclamatory sentence- It expresses strong feeling. Exap- what a nice!

d.Interrogative Sentence-Those which ask question.Exap- Where do you live?

SUBJECT AND PREDICATE

Subject is about which/whom, something is spoken and Predicate is the part, which tells about Subject.

Exap-Mohan (is a farmer).

Mohan is Subject and Predicate is in bracket.

NOTE:- PHRASE is a group of words, which make some sense , but not complete sense.

Exap- I met Ravi on the road.

On the road, by itself, dose not make complete sense.
