The words in coloumn A does not make any sense and we are unable to get any meaning out of it.

But the words on coloumn B makes sense. We are able to understand the meaning of the words.

Thus,

A sentence is a group of words or combination of words that gives us a complete sense.

Ex: Ram is a boy.

Kinds of sentence:

1) Assertive/ declarative sentence- a sentence that makes a simple statement or assertion is called and assertive or declarative sentence.

Ex: The sun rises in the East.

2) interrogative sentence- a sentence that ask a question or makes an enquiry is called an interrogative sentence.

Ex: Who is that lady?

3) Imperative sentence- a sentence that express an advice, an order, a command, a forbidding or an entreaty is called an imperative sentence.

Ex: Take off your shoes.

4) Optative sentence- a sentence that expresses a wish or prayer is called an optative sentence.

Ex: May God bless us all!

5) Exclamatory sentence- a sentence that expresses a sudden or strong feeling is called an exclamatory sentence.

Ex- What a beautiful dress!

Phrase- A phrase is a group of words that makes sense but not complete sense. That is because it does not have a finite verb.

Ex- It was a sunrise of great beauty

[Finite verb- verb that changes with person,number and tense.]

Wh.... Questions:

Wh.... questions are of three types:

- 1) Interrogative pronouns:
- (a) Who, Whose, Whom (for persons only). Who is used as a subject, Whose is used as a possessive and Whom is used as object.
- **(b)** What(ideas etc.) which(choice).
- 2) Interrogative adjectives: what, which and whose. (followed by noun)
- 3) Interrogative adverbs: When(time),where(place),why(reason),how(method),how much(quantity),how many(number),how long(period of time),how far(distance),how often(frequency),how soon(period of time).
